Theatre Company 11 Assignments

This course is divided into 7 units:

- You've Been Cast!
- History and Stagecraft
- The Actor's Workbook
- The Actor's Warmup
- Myself and Others
- Auditions and College
- Final Rehearsal, Final Submissions

Students will complete 5 projects and be evaluated by the director of the production they participate in. All of the projects have a detailed description of what is required, so students are clear about expectations. The course provides rich information which will support the student in completing the projects.

Required Projects

- Sharing Your Starting Point a self-assessment at the start of the course to establish where they are starting from
- Warmup Video a video of you completing your actor's warmup
- Actor's Workbook contains all of the research and decisions about your performance and process, along with video of your performance of a monologue or scene from the play, submitted in 2 parts

The Sharing Your Starting Point project needs to be <u>completed</u> <u>within 3 weeks</u> of registering for the course.
